## Evaluation Methods Used:

A sample set of pages were identified to perform the audit. The pages were tested using:

- Windows 10 /Chrome/JAWS 2021
- Windows 10/Firefox/NVDA 2022
- Windows 10/Edge/Narrator
- MAC 11/Safari/VoiceOver
- Windows / Chrome /ZoomText 2022
- Windows / Chrome /Dragon Naturally Speaking 15

Accessibility testers performed the audit using:

- Automated tools
  - W3C Markup Validation Service
  - Color contrast checker
- Code Inspection
- Keyboard-only interaction
- Screen readers
- Screen magnifier
- Speech recognition

Accessibility testers performed the test keeping WCAG 2.1 guidelines in mind.
